Replace broken intermediate posts in Block G
Install vine training string & guards on Block G Pinot Meunier trunk to cordon wire.
Blocks D, E, F & G drip tube installation.
Continue drip tube removal and replacement in Blocks A, B, C & H.
Fertiliser spreading in Block H, I & J
Bed forming in Blocks H, I & J
Cultivate vine strip in Blocks H, I & J.
Block H, I & J post mark out.
Post installation in Blocks H, I & J
Irrigation installation in Blocks H, I & J.

## VITICULTURAL COMMENTS

Wet days have continued through October with 14 wet days and approximately 70mm recorded so far.

Disease pressure remains high due to continual rainfall. Disease monitoring has increased on site due to the weather conditions. A Downy Mildew protectant & eradicant fungicide may be required at next Foliar Spray application..
